Course Placements

Students are placed in courses based on specific criteria. Prerequisite requirements reflect skills and levels of achievement needed for success in a desired course. Proper academic placement is essential for academic success; therefore, students will not be placed in courses in which the pre-requisite requirements have not been met.

Course placement is contingent upon the final *unweighted* course grade. If a student fails to meet a pre-requisite *unweighted* grade requirement by three or less points but has fulfilled all other pre-requisites, a parent may request placement in the desired course by completing a placement waiver. This is the only circumstance for which placement waivers will be offered.
